# COST AND SPACE

The cost per month for full-time attendance (2-4 days a week) is \$40 for the first child, \$30 for the second and any additional children. In order for students to attend part-time (1-2 days a week), the cost is only \$20 a month. All payments are due at the beginning of each month to hold your child's spot in the program.

We also have an opportunity for parents to pay the entire year in full – with this, you will receive the month of May free. If you choose this option, the fees for the year are \$320.00 first child and \$240.00 for the second child or any additional children.

**The monthly fee holds your child's space for the month and provides the daily, healthy snack each student receives, as well as assistance with supplies for the month. We do have limited space, so please sign up early to ensure a spot in our program.**

If you would like to participate in our program but cannot afford the monthly payments, please contact your child's school.

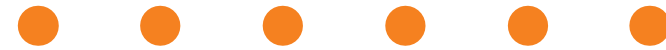
