# Why iPads?

- Potential for students to have access to classroom content 24/7
- Educational and productivity apps augment direct instruction
- The students “have the world at their fingertips.”
- Innovation in our learning environment that leads to increased achievement
- Aligns with 21<sup>st</sup> century learning goals

# Just the facts, ma'am!

- Who: Every student in our school
- What: One iPad for every student
- Where: With parent permission, students take their iPad home
- Why: We want to give our students and staff the most current tool to enhance learning in our schools
- When: October 5, 2011, is our target

# Important Details

- iPads to be kept in school-issued protective case
- Students responsible for bringing charged iPad to school each day
- Students will use their own iTunes account to manage apps, music, etc.
- School-issued student email address
- Training provided to students on October 5<sup>th</sup>

# APP-solutely!!

- Four iTunes Options:
  - Existing family account
  - Existing student account
  - Establish new account with or without credit card
  - Loaner status iPad – school owned iTunes account

# WiFi Connectivity

- The iPads connect to the Internet wirelessly.
- WiFi available at school
- Around town: library, Powell Aquatic Center, McDonald's

# Financial Responsibility

- Families are responsible for all costs associated with repairing and/or replacing the iPad (includes lost/stolen iPads).
- Recommended Insurance:
  - Homeowner's Insurance
  - Renter's Insurance
  - Low-cost electronic device insurance

# Technical Difficulties

- Factory Defect – Applecare provides a limited 3-year warranty
- Damage and other problems to be reported to Mr. Starcevich in the library – Incident Report Form
- Student-run help center

# Lost and Found

- Lost iPads should be reported to Mr. Starcevich in the library.
- Incidents of theft should be reported to the PHS administration.
- We recommend you file a police report in all instances.

# Beware!

- Yes, there are some awful things out there in cyberland.
- We ALL need to have THE TALK with OUR kids. Review THE POLICY with your son or daughter.
- We have firewalls in place at school, and we can help parents locate apps to help with home monitoring.

# The School Owns The iPad

- No expectation of privacy
- Can be searched at any time
- Students are not allowed to clear the Internet cache (history)
- Violations = loss of privilege and additional consequences
